PARK RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Park hours are from dawn to dusk.
2. Glass containers are prohibited.
3. Alcoholic beverage consumption is prohibited without a permit.
4. Littering is prohibited – trash receptacles and trash bags are provided by the park district and are located under the existing trash bag. Applicant is required to remove trash bags from the park at the conclusion of park use.
5. Scooters and skateboards prohibited.
6. Motorized vehicles prohibited off roadways and beyond parking areas.
7. Improperly parked vehicles will be towed.
8. Fires are prohibited except in barbecue grills.
9. Vending or sales prohibited without permit.
10. Firearms and weapons of any kind are prohibited.
11. Hunting, trapping, or killing of animals or birds is prohibited.
12. Pets are to remain on leash at all times.
13. Pet owners are required to pick up after their pets.
14. Control noise levels – please be respectful of others.
15. No overnight camping is permitted.
