



Dickens Village Festival Lighted Parade Float Grant

The Dickens Village Festival Committee has established a grant program for creating or upgrading a float unit for the Dickens Festival Lighted Parade.

Overview

Who is eligible: All Garrison based businesses, groups and organizations regardless of prior participation.

Amount of grant available: \$200.00

Deadline for submission: No later than September 1

Method of submission: Applications should be mailed to Dickens Village Festival at PO Box 521, Garrison, ND 58540. Or delivered to the Garrison CVB Office in the ND Firefighters Museum on Main Street.

Method of Selection: The applications will be reviewed by the Dickens Village Committee and judged on theme and creativity. This is a competitive grant.

Guidelines

1. Submit a written narrative proposal of your parade entry project describing the theme and construction elements to be used. Try to be as detailed as possible. Include how you intend to use the funds.
2. A minimum of \$200 must be spent on the project.
3. This grant is competitive. Sketches of project are optional but may be included as an enhancement.
4. Enclose the application form with your written proposal.
5. Parade units should have a Victorian theme, a Christmas or Holiday theme or a theme that reflects the business or organization.
6. ALL entries must be lighted in some way.
7. Sound is optional.
8. Enclose the application form with your narrative proposal.
9. Grantees MUST have their units appear in all seven nights of parades. The only exception will be in the event of an official cancellation of the parade by the Dickens Village Festival Committee.
